THIS POLICY APPLIES TO ALL MEMBERS REGISTERED WITH
THE NOHA AND OWHA WITHIN TSMHA

Affiliation Policy

NOHA Registered Players

1. As per NOHA Regulation R.7.13, TSMHA will register their Affiliation Declaration as: Specially Affiliated Players.
2. With the Specially Affiliated Players List, affiliate players must be:
 - a. From a lower age division and same or lower category
 - b. Same age, lower category
3. Therefore the affiliations for TSMHA teams are as follows:

Rep Teams

- U18 "C" - U18 House, U15 "C", U15 House
- U15 "A" – U15 "C", U15 House, U13 "A", U13 "C"
- U15 "C" - U15 House, U13 "C", U13 House
- U13 "A" - U13 "C", U13 House, U11 "A", U11 "C"
- U13 "C" - U13 House, U11 "C", U11 House
- U11 "A" - U11 "C", U11 House
- U11 "C" - U11 House
- U9 Affiliation is to follow the Hockey Canada U9 Pathway

House Teams

- U18 House – U15 House
- U15 House – U13 House
- U13 House – U11 House
- U11 House – U9 to Follow the U9 Hockey Canada Pathway
- U9 to follow the U9 Hockey Canada Pathway

At this Time TSMHA only has NOHA “A” “C” and House league teams registered. If TSMHA cards teams other than those listed teams will only be able to affiliate players from a lower age group or level. The above listed divisions are only a guideline for the teams currently registered with TSMHA.

4. As per NOHA Regulation R.7.9, in any affiliation, the player must have permission from the coach or manager of the team they are carded with before the affiliated player can participate in any game or in any practice. Failure to receive permission may result in suspension of the coach.
5. A maximum of two (2) affiliate players are allowed to practice with their affiliate team at a time. After participating in more than five (5) TSMHA designated practices with the affiliate team, the affiliated player will have to pay an affiliate player fee of \$125.00. Goalies are exempted from this policy.
6. An affiliated player can only play in a game in place of an injured or absent carded player. U9/ U11 / U13 House Divisions can only use an affiliate player if they have less than 10 skaters. U15 and U18 House Divisions can only use affiliate players if they have less than 12 skaters. Special requests can be made in writing by the team to the TSMHA president if circumstance require. Goalies may be used as required.
7. NOHA carded players can only be affiliated with one team.
8. Any team which is affiliating players within the NOHA also has to file an affiliation form with the TSMHA which would include the player’s name and a parent or guardian signature.
9. All house league registered teams must first obtain permission from one of the following; TSMHA President, TSMHA Vice President or TSMHA Division Representative prior to affiliation to ensure fair play, and parity within the TSMHA house program.

OWHA Registered Players

1. OWHA players will affiliate with OWHA registered teams within the regulations set out by the OWHA as per the OWHA rules and regulations handbook.
2. The player must have permission from the coach or manager of the team they are carded with before the affiliated player can participate in any game or in any practice. Failure to receive permission may result in suspension of the coach.
3. An affiliated player can only play in a game in place of an injured or absent carded player.
4. OWHA players can only be affiliated with one team.
5. Affiliate players must be:
 - a. From a lower age division
 - b. Same age, lower category

- U11 "B"- U11 "C", U11 House, U9 to follow the U9 Hockey Canada Pathway

House Teams

- U18 House – U15 House
- U15 House – U13 House

- U13 House – U11 House
- U11 House – U9 to follow the U9 Hockey Canada Pathway

At this Time TSMHA only has OWHA “BB”, “B”, “C” and House league teams registered. If TSMHA cards teams other than those listed teams will only be able to affiliate players from a lower age group or level. The above listed divisions are only a guideline for the teams currently registered with TSMHA.

6. There is no limit on the number of practices or games that a player may play with an affiliate team, however a player must play a minimum of 5 OWHA sanctioned games to be eligible for OWHA Provincial Championships.

OWHA Players registering with both a NOHA and an OWHA team:

1. Any female player wishing to be fully rostered on both an OWHA and NOHA team must:
 - a) Receive permission from both the OWHA and NOHA teams
 - b) Pay the full current registration fee for the second team registration fee.
 - c) Pay both TSMHA rep fees
 - d) Pay all applicable team fees
 - e) Be subject to one player’s allotment of car draw ticket sales.

This will allow for the female player to play on both teams without either team having an absent player.
